What's the difference?

Dates are important when enrolling new members!

When you process an enrolment, the **Date of Employment** is the **hire date** (i.e. first day the employee started with you) and the **Date of Enrolment** is the date the employee is **enrolled in MEPP** (i.e. first day the employee was deducted pension contributions for MEPP for hours worked). At times these dates will be the same. See the Employer Guide for eligibility rules.

Example: If you hire Randi and their first day of work is June 15, then **June 15** is the date entered as the **Date of Employment**. Then, if you start deducting MEPP contributions on August 17, then **August 17** is the **Date of Enrolment**.
